

## Possible interlude for "I Give You My Heart", words and music by Reuben Morgan

At the end of 2nd chorus, go to this progression rather than the E major chord that usually ends the chorus. Repeat section as desired. When ready to return to either verse or chorus, play A/B on last beat of 4th bar.
